Hot Lunch *order on HeadMaster*

Hot lunch will be served each Wednesday. It will NOT be served this week. The first hot lunch will be on Sept. 7.

ORDERS: Hot lunch slips will not be sent home each week. You **must** order your child's lunch through logging in on HeadMaster. HeadMaster is easily accessed on the academy's website (cbapatriots.org). HeadMaster is on the homepage in green. When you sign in on HeadMaster:

1. Log in
2. Click on the Lunch Tab (upper right of the page)
3. Click on your students' name tab (repeat for each student in family)
4. Click on Order Lunch Tab
5. Choose lunch date
6. Choose quantity and submit
7. Orders must be placed by Tuesday

You may order up to a month in advance or just a week at a time.

ACCOUNTS: If you wish to have an account, please send in your money in an envelope labeled "hot lunch account" with your name on it and it will be put in an account for your child or children. When your account is low, you will be notified. If you choose not to do an account your child will need to bring the amount due on Wednesday and pay in the lunch line.

COST: The cost for lunch is now \$3.00 and an extra serving is \$1.00

Milk Ticket-\$7.00

Milk is available in pint sizes for the students to purchase. The flavors are white, strawberry, and chocolate. A milk ticket is \$7 this year and is good for 20 milks. A single milk is \$.40. If you would like to purchase a milk ticket, you may send in the money with your child to give to their homeroom teacher. Please send a note stating it is for a milk ticket. When the ticket is close to being used up, the teacher will send a note home to let you know.
